

## [Participation in the ACP Platform: Partners and Membership development policy]

### Criteria

Organizations that have expressed interest in actively working with the access to culture platform may be invited to join.

The following criteria will be followed:

- [ non-for-profit organisations
- [ non-governmental organisations
- [ multipliers working on an European level
- [ one representative in the working groups (wg) per organisation

### Procedure

New members:

- [ proposed / invited by an acp member organisation
- [ fill in a short commitment statement identifying their motivation to contribute to the work of the acp (see below)
- [ inform the secretariat about the working group(s) they are most interested in participating in
- [ inform the secretariat about the contact details of the representative of the organisation to the acp. Include a short bio / Europass CV and photo.
- [ The proposal is communicated to the plenary. If in the space of 2 weeks there is no disagreement or if members disagreeing are less than 1/3 of the acp members the new proposed member is accepted.

The call for members can be online with the form to be filled out together with the new acp mission statement (to be prepared in the next weeks by the advisory group). Every new member by filling in the form and asking for participation understands that it is committing to active participation and to the mission statement.
